Candidate registration: **11 – 14 September 2026 (on the last day, until 12:00 noon)** (online, on the dedicated platform for this purpose, <https://admitereonline.utcluj.ro/>)

Interview: **September 15, 2026** (according to the schedule posted after the registration period)

Posting preliminary results: **September 15, 2026 (after 18:00)**

Submission of appeals: **September 16, 2026** (they will be formulated and sent to the email address: contestatiiadmitere@utcluj.ro **until 12:00 noon**)

Appeals resolution: **September 16, 2026**

Posting of results after appeals have been resolved: **September 16, 2026 (after 16:00)**

Confirmation of places: **September 17, 2026 (between 8:00 - 14:00)** (onsite, at the Secretariat of the Automation Department, room 350, str. G. Barițiu, nr. 26-28, Cluj-Napoca)

Posting of the final results of the summer session: **September 17, 2026 (after 16:00)**.

CANDIDATE REGISTRATION:

Important: During the registration period, candidates are asked to periodically consult their email in order to solve the notifications sent by the commission for the validation of the dossier.

Documents required for registration (according to Art. 3.5. of the TUCN Master's Admission Regulations 2026 - 2027):

A. Electronically completed documents:

A.1. **Application form** - to be filled in online. Based on it, the registration form will be generated in the candidate's dossier.

B. Documents scanned in electronic format:

B.1. **Bachelor's degree** (or equivalent) or **graduation certificate** (only for the current year's promotion); **Diploma supplement** for previous promotions;

B.2. **Affidavit** regarding the number of years the candidate has benefited from state-funded (budgeted) master's studies (to be downloaded from the platform);

B.3. **Birth certificate**;

B.4. **Identity card**;

B.5. **Marriage certificate** (if applicable);

B.6. **Proof of payment of the registration fee** or supporting documents regarding the fee exemption (according to Art. 3.3 of the TUCN Master's Admission Regulations 2026 - 2027). Payment can be made by card directly within the admission platform, by bank transfer or postal order. B.7. **Medical certificate**, issued by the family doctor or by the territorial or company dispensary – as the case may be – to which they belong; Candidates with chronic conditions will present a medical certificate endorsed by the county medical commissions for school and professional guidance, which will expressly mention the degree of deficiencies, their location, according to the medical criteria of school and professional guidance. Failure to declare these conditions can entail the institutional consequences in force. The validity of the medical certificate is **three months** from the date of issuance according to the legislation in force;

B.8. If applicable, supporting **documents regarding the funding of the master's studies at the university from which the candidate graduated**;

B.9. The form containing **Project proposal** for research/development activity, according to Art. 5.2 (1) of the Methodology of the Faculty of Automation and Computer Science for admission to master's degree studies ([Annex 2. Project template \(ro\)](#) / [Annex 2. Project template \(en\)](#)). The project proposal must be **signed** and uploaded in PDF format.

B.10. **Document certifying English language proficiency for candidates who apply to the Cyber Physical Systems (CPS) study programme (regardless of the position in which the programme is listed among their choices)**, as follows:

- *An internationally recognized English language proficiency certificate, at a minimum B2 level (e.g. Cambridge, IELTS, LCCI, Sprachdiplom, etc.), which must have been validated by the Department of Modern Languages and Communication of TUCN;*

- *An English language proficiency certificate, at a minimum B2 level, issued by the Department of Modern Languages and Communication of TUCN;*

- *Candidates who have completed bachelor's or master's degree studies taught in English may prove their language proficiency by submitting their degree diploma / graduation certificate;*

- *A certificate confirming that the candidate studied English as a subject for at least two semesters during their Bachelor's degree studies and passed it with an average grade of at least 8.00.*

C. In addition, only for candidates who are found in Art. 2.2 (5) of the TUCN 2026 - 2027 Master's Admission Regulations:

C.1. **Declaration on own responsibility**, based on the freely expressed will, of assuming the Romanian cultural identity, according to the legislation in force, according to Annex no. 3 of the methodology specific to Romanian candidates everywhere, except for candidates from the Republic of Moldova;

C.2. **Residence permit**, as the case may be;

C.3. **Passport** – copy of the first three pages, according to the specific methodology;

C.4. **CNRED Certificate**;

C.5. **Other documents requested by the CES/ORI Committee.**

D. In the case of candidates who present identity documents, studies and medical certificates issued outside Romania, it is necessary to supplement the file with an authorized translation of them into Romanian, English or French.
